day 1 2009

Early morning arrival Ben Gurion Airport

Meet and assist By Tailor Made Representative.

Drive to Tel Aviv for Breakfast

Sightseeing of Tel Aviv and the ancient Jaffa, visit the home of Simon the Tanner and Continue to Caesarea to Roman capital of Judea. Here we view the beautifully restored theater, and the ruins of the ancient town, its harbor and aqueduct Overnight; Tiberias

day 2 2009

We'll begin this day with a boat ride on the sea of Galilee , continue to Capernaum and visit the ruins of the ancient synagogue. Continue to the Mt. of Beatitudes, site of the Sermon on the Mount. In the early afternoon a visit to the Lebanon border and the Site – Rosh-Hanikra with the Beautiful water

caves, then we'll drive to Acco for a walk around the walls and visit to the “white market” and port.

Overnight: Tiberius

Day3 2009

Excursion to Galilee, we will begin with Safed (Tzfat) – birthplace of Kabala – Jewish mystic teachings, the Old city, the Ancient synagogues and the artist colony. Drive to the Golan Heights for an easy hiking in the Golan including going to the Baniyas springs, the source of the Jordan River, continue to Tel Dan, one of the most spectacular nature resort and also a biblical town. We will go up Mount Bental for a panoramic view over Israel and Syria Overnight: Tiberius

Day4 2009

After breakfast we drive Via the Armagedon Valley to Megiddo. Continue to visit the Muhraka on Mt Carmel, where Elijah defeated the priests of Ba'al. we will continue to Daliat-El-Carmel, the Druz village on top of the Carmel mountain for a special visit to hear about the special Druz community in Israel from one of the community leaders, free time to visit the Druz market.,.

Overnight: Jerusalem
